## DOLE ANNOUNCES HEARINGS ON CLINTON PARKWAY

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that the Senate Public Works Committee will hold hearings April 24th on his bill to construct the Clinton Parkway in Lawrence.

The bill authorizes \$6 million to build a 4.1 mile access road from 23d and Iowa Streets in Lawrence to the site of Clinton Lake. The legislation was introduced by Senator Dole on March 8.

"I am pleased that the Public Works Committee has responded so promptly to my request for consideration of this bill," Senator Dole said. "There is a strong case for building this road to meet the highway needs of the Lawrence area and to avoid unnecessary hardship and hazard to Clinton Lake visitors. The testimony of city and county officials and other concerned citizens will be most helpful. Hopefully, a strong delegation from Lawrence and Douglas County will be able to appear before the Committee. And I would urge those who cannot attend to send me their views for inclusion in the official hearing record."

"Senator James Pearson, Congressman Larry Winn and I have been working together on this problem for some time now, and these hearings will be a significant opportunity to bring it to the attention of the Public Works Committee in full detail."
