DOLE ANNOUNCES 5 MILLION GALLONS ADDITIONAL KANSAS FUEL

MANHATTAN, KANSAS--Senator Bob Dole announced today Federal Energy officials have approved more than a 5 million increase in the April gasoline allocation for Kansas.

Earlier this week Dole had requested an FEO review of the Kansas allocation figures. Today John Sawhill, Deputy Administrator of the Federal Energy Office contacted Dole in Manhattan, Kansas reporting that FEO recomputations indicated that a five million gallon increase in the Kansas April allocation was justified.

Today's announcement will boost the April Kansas gasoline supplies to 115.5 million gallons.

Dole made the announcement during a speech at the Circle K Club's District Convention at Kansas State University.
