## IMPACT AID MONEY TO KANSAS SCHOOLS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that \$66,896 has been certified for immediate payment to five Kansas school districts by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

This money is made available through Title I of Public Law 874 which provides financial assistance to school in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas School districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineligible for federal impact aid funds by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

Following are the school districts and money that has been certified for each:
