KANSAN APPOINTED TO NATIONAL ADVISORY MENTAL HEALTH COUNCIL

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole announced this morning that Dr. Loren F. Taylor of Mission, Kansas has been invited to serve on the National Advisory Mental Health Council of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare. Dole had recommended Dr. Taylor to HEW Secretary Caspar W. Weinberger for the post.

Dr. Taylor, who is Director of Cardiothoracic Anesthesia at St. Lukes Hospital, also holds a law degree. He was previously an Anesthesiologist at the K.U. Medical Center. Dr. Taylor also served for 1 1/2 years as Deputy Executive Director for the President's Commission on Medical Malpractice, beginning in 1971.

His appointment to the National Advisory Mental Health Council will run through 1977.
