## DOLE SEES REG CHANGE HELPFUL ON HARVEST FUEL, GETS INTERIM FERTILIZER REPORT

Salina, Kansas --- Senator Bob Dole called the Federal Energy Office's new mandatory fuel allocation rules "a major step in the right direction" in the effort to ensure adequate farm fuel supplies during harvest.

FEO announced earlier this week that changes in its regulations, designed to guarantee that farmers received the 100 percent-of-need fuel supply they have been promised, would be published in the Federal Register on Monday.
