## FUNDING FOR SUMMER JOB PROGRAMS AWARDED

Senator Bob Dole announced today that the U. S. Department of Labor plans to distribute over \$2.2 million for summer jobs programs throughout Kansas this summer.

These programs, sponsored by local city and county officials, create job opportunities for disadvantaged students by making funding available for wage subsidies.

Of the \$2.2 million total funding for the state, \$337,000 will go to Kansas City summer jobs programs, \$203,000 to Topeka, and \$457,500 to Wichita. The balance will be distributed throughout the state.

Of the total funding intended, approximately 30% is immediately available to Regional Manpower officials in the Department of Labor. These funds can be distributed to local summer job program sponsors so that planning and job development efforts may begin.

Students hired under the program are generally employed for a nine week period.
