## \$265,913 IN IMPACT AID FUNDS TO SERVE FOUR KANSAS SCHOOL DISTRICTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare has certified a total of \$265,913. for immediate payment to four federally affected school districts in Kansas.

This money is made available through Title I of Public law 874 which provides financial assistance to schools in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas school districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineligible for federal impact aid funds by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

\$107,104 was certified for immediate payment to 12 Kansas school districts yesterday.

Following are the school districts and money that has been certified today :

Topeka USD #501	\$175,488.
Westmoreland USD #323	\$3,859.
Gardner USD #231	\$26,613.
Kansas City USD #500	\$59,953.
