## \$285,015. IN IMPACT AID FUNDS TO 13 KANSAS SCHOOL DISTRICTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education and Welfare has certified a total of \$288,110 for immediate payment to ~~11~~ <sup>13</sup> federally affected school districts in Kansas.

This money is made available through Title I of Public Law 874 which provides financial assistance to schools in federally affected areas. An amendment added by Dole to the School Lunch Bill made 94 federally impacted Kansas school districts eligible for federal payments during 1974. Kansas had previously been found ineligible for federal impact aid funds by the the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.

\$373,017 had been certified earlier this week for immediate payment to 16 Kansas school districts, bringing the total of money made available this week to \$661,110.
