KANSAS RECEIVES \$1,858,225. FROM LABOR DEPARTMENT

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$1,858,225 grant to the state of Kansas from the Department of Labor under three Manpower Programs. The funds have been granted by Congress to provide employment assistance funds either through public service employment programs or through funding of job-training programs.

Under Section 5 of the Emergency Employment Act \$1,500,000 is being allocated for Kansas, \$2,425 is being allocated under special Indian programs, and a total of \$355,800 is being allocated under the Public Service Employment Act for the Kansas City, Wichita, and Topeka areas for job assistance in relatively high unemployment areas.

No time limit for grant funding has been specified, and specific allocation of funds will be made by state officials.
