WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced two Department of Labor grants totaling nearly a million dollars to provide summer jobs for Kansas youth.

The City of Topeka received a \$120,010 grant and the Governor's office received \$847,731 for its summer jobs program, which serves about 3,800 youth in areas not covered by a local prime sponsor.

These funds are the first to be allocated in the State under the new Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA). Under CETA, responsibility for planning and executing manpower programs is turned over to states; cities and counties with over 100,000 population; or groups of local governments of at least one has more than 100,000 population.
