## DOLE LEGISLATION WILL EXTEND KANSAS PROGRAMS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole announced today that he and three other Senators will join together as sponsors of legislation to extend federal funding of the Economic Opportunity Foundation of Wyandotte County. The legislation would create an independent Community Service and Community Economic Development Administration to fund the programs previously sponsored by the Office of Economic Opportunity.

Dole said the legislation will enable EOE to continue to address the needs of disadvantaged residents of Wyandotte county, and also contains a new Community Partnership program to assist local and state government in strengthening the capability of public and private community institutions in undertaking anti-poverty efforts.

The legislation will be formally introduced in the Senate next Wednesday.
