GRANTS TOTALLING \$190,625 TO TOPEKA PUBLIC SCHOOLS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced that the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, through the Office of Education, has awarded two grants, totalling \$190,625, to the Topeka Public School System. The grants are for the operation of a Follow-Through Center, which is designed to sustain and augment in the early primary grades the gains in instruction, health, and nutrition that children from low-income families make in Headstart and other quality pre-school programs.
