DOLE TO ATTEND ECONOMIC CONFERENCE

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole has been chosen as one of four Senators to attend an Agriculture and Food Economic Conference to be held in Chicago on September 13. He is one of two Republicans chosen by the Republican leadership in the Senate.

Delegates at the Conference will identify the main causes of inflation and give their observations on the effects of inflation on agriculture and food. The group will also explore what the government can do, as well as what individual, private groups and private business can do to help curb inflation.

Approximately 60 delegates from various phases of agriculture, as well as consumers and labor representatives, have been invited to attend the Conference.

The ideas and consensus developed at this Agriculture and Food Economic Conference will be passed along to the Conference on Inflation that has been called by President Ford for September 27-28. All delegates will also be invited to attend Ford's Conference on Inflation in Washington, D.C.
