## SENATOR BOB DOLE ANNOUNCES AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE FIELD HEARING

WASHINGTON.....Senator Bob Dole (R-Kan) today announced the U.S. Senate Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition and Forestry will hold an official field hearing concerning the current farm economic situation in Memorial Hall, 600 N. 7th Street, Kansas City, Kansas, at 9:00 am Monday, January 16, 1978.

Senator Dole said the hearing was called to fulfill a commitment he made to farmers in December. "I told farmers the Senate Agriculture Committee would hold a hearing to allow farmers to present at an official hearing ideas for action by the Congress and the Administration. I hope the hearing will be constructive and will allow ideas to be presented for improving the economic condition found today in agriculture."
