DOLE TO MEET WITH E.P.A. OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS HAZARDOUS WASTES

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) will meet Wednesday with representatives of the Environmental Protection Agency to discuss potential hazardous waste and groundwater contamination in Kansas.

Senator Dole requested the meeting as part of his continuing efforts to monitor the possible impact of toxic waste sites on the state.

The meeting will take place in Senator Dole's Washington office at 11:00 A.M. EDT. Participating will be Swep Davis, Associate Assistant Administrator for Water and Waste Management, Jeffrey Miller, Assistant Administrator for Enforcement, and Administrator Douglas Costle.

"I view this meeting as an important opportunity to find out E.P.A.'s views and to express the concerns of Kansans on this subject," said Senator Dole.
