DOLE FEATURED SPEAKER AT NATIONAL PIZZA HUT CONVENTION

SAN FRANCISCO----Kansas Senator Robert J. Dole will be the featured speaker Thursday morning at the National Pizza Hut Convention in San Francisco. The Senator will be the keynote speaker at a breakfast for more than 800 franchisees from across the country, including many from the Wichita area.

Pizza Hut officials have invited Senator Dole, the Chairman of the tax-writing Senate Finance Committee, to speak on a variety of economic issues. Senator Dole's remarks, entitled "Washington's 1982 Impact on Business", will focus on President Reagan's recently announced budget proposals, "new Federalism" and an economic outlook for the coming fiscal years.

The address will be followed by a question and answer session for Pizza Hut conventioners, and then a general news conference.

Prominent Wichita Pizza Hut participants in San Francisco include Jamie Coulter and Ken Miller, who played a key role in securing Senator Dole for the convention breakfast.
