## DOLE SUPPORTS COFFEYVILLE GRANT REQUESTS

Senator Bob Dole (R-KS), today sent letters to the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Federal Aviation Administration in support of grant applications filed by the city of Coffeyville.

In the letters Dole noted the meritorious objectives of the grant requests as well as the need to boost a local economy suffering from a unemployment rate in excess of 15%. Dole noted that the HUD grant would "provide a shot in the arm to a badly sagging local economy".

In announcing the letters, Dole said, "I am optimistic that these grants will be favorably reviewed and I believe we are on the brink of sustained economic recovery. But we are not there yet, and I will do everything I can to support these applications for grants that could help put citizens of Coffeyville back to work".

The City has filed with the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a \$1,000,000 grant under the Small Cities Program and has filed with the FAA for an airport improvements grant in the amount of \$1,670,300.

The City of Coffeyville, Kansas recently filed an application with the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a \$1,000,000 grant under the Small Cities Program. I am writing to encourage your favorable consideration of that request.

The grant will serve a number of valuable functions, including rehabilitation of single family dwellings, economic development for new business, installation of water lines, street repair and storm sewer improvements. While certain of those functions will not directly insure long-term employment, they will act to create a favorable environment in which to retain and attract new business.
