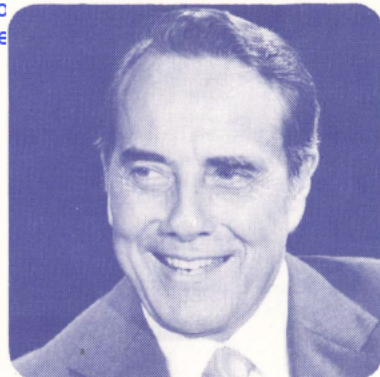

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DOLE, KASSEBAUM ANNOUNCE \$12 MILLION+ CONTRACT FOR FORT RILEY

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum today announced a \$12,173,000 U.S. Army contract for work to be performed at Fort Riley. The contractor is Sherwood and Myers, of Wichita.

The work to be performed consists of the construction of a training range, a cantonment area, and sitework. Included in the training range will be an ammo loading dock, an administration building, a range control tower, vault latrines, emplacements for targets, a synchronization pad (with a ramp), and a staging area. The cantonment area is composed of six multipurpose buildings, a target maintenance building, a latrine and shower building, a water supply system, and a sanitary sewage system. The site work consists of extensive earthworks, security fencing, sidewalks, exterior lighting, utilities and paving.
