RUDMAN TO JOIN ARMS CONTROL OBSERVER GROUP

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today announced that Senator Warren Rudman (R-N.H.) would be his representative on the Senate Arms Control Observer Group in Geneva from Feb. 6-16.

The group was established in January 1985 to help keep the Senate informed of the progress of the arms control negotiations and respond to requests by the administration for advice on the conduct of the talks.

In addition to the ten Senate observers, Senator Dole and Senate Minority Leader Robert C. Byrd (D-W.Va.) are ex-officio members of the group.

"I know Warren will do an outstanding job in this important arms control mission," Dole said. "As a freshman he has already had quite an impact in the Senate and I'm looking forward to his input from Geneva."
