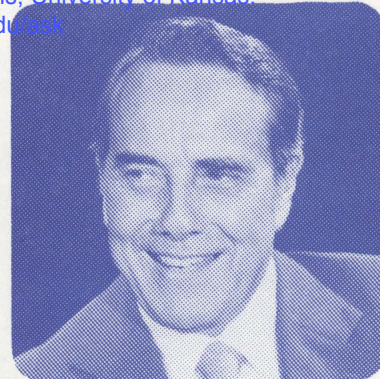

## SHEILA BURKE NAMED CHIEF OF STAFF

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today announced that he has named Sheila P. Burke, Chief of Staff, Office of the Majority Leader. Currently Deputy Chief of Staff, Ms. Burke will replace Roderick DeArment, who is joining the law firm of Covington and Burling.

Ms. Burke served as Deputy Staff Director of the Senate Committee on Finance from 1982-1985, and was a professional staff member of the committee from 1979-1982.

She now serves on the adjunct faculty of the Georgetown University School of Nursing and the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing. From 1980-1981 she was a research assistant at the Center for Health Policy and Management at the John F. Kennedy School for Government at Harvard University in Boston.

Ms. Burke, who is a native of San Francisco, California, earned a Master of Public Administration from Harvard University and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing at the University of San Francisco.

Early in her career she worked as a staff nurse in Berkeley, Calif., and was Director of Program and Field Services for the National Student Nurses Association in New York.
