DOLE EARNS 12TH "WATCHDOG OF TREASURY"
AWARD FOR FISCAL INTEGRITY

Washington, DC -- Senator Bob Dole today received his 12th "golden bulldog" award from the Watchdogs of the Treasury, Inc., for his leadership in fiscal integrity on behalf of taxpayers.

Using an "economy voting" record to determine who is honored, the nonpartisan Watchdog of the Treasury presented 32 other Senators and 136 members of the House with similar awards today. Few members of Congress have earned the award more times than Sen. Dole.

The award is presented annually to members of Congress who advocate fiscal responsibility - voting to hold down federal spending and committed to reducing the deficit - at least 75-percent of the time.
