DOLE HAILS ANDREWS APPOINTMENT TO EXPORT COUNCIL

WASHINGTON -- President Reagan's special export panel added "a powerful voice from the heartlands" with the appointment today of Senator Mark Andrews (R-ND), according to Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-KS).

The President's Export Council is a 28-member national advisory board that works with the Administration to expand U.S. exports.

"With commodity surpluses continuing to pile up in the Midwest, it is more important than ever to find ways to move this bounty overseas. That's why Mark Andrews was picked for this important role in shaping American export policy. He will be a powerful voice from the heartlands on the President's Council," Dole said.
