### DOLE PREDICTS VICTORY - RAPS UP 43-STATE CAMPAIGN BLITZ

Washington, DC -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-KS) predicted today the U.S. Senate will remain Republican, that Republicans will hold their own in the House and that Republicans will pick up a number of governorships. Dole makes his final campaign appearance for 1986 in Wichita, Kansas, on Monday.

Since the beginning of this year, Sen. Dole has traveled to 43 states - many states more than once - on behalf of Republican candidates. During this time, he has appeared at 460 political events of various kinds.

Campaign America, Sen. Dole's political action committee, reports Dole visited 126 cities on behalf of 95 Republican candidates at the local, state and national level.

The majority leader's final campaign swing began on Oct. 27 and took him to Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota, Idaho, Washington, Oregon, California, Colorado, North Carolina and Kansas.

Notwithstanding his heavy travel schedule, Sen. Dole missed only one Senate vote in 1986.
