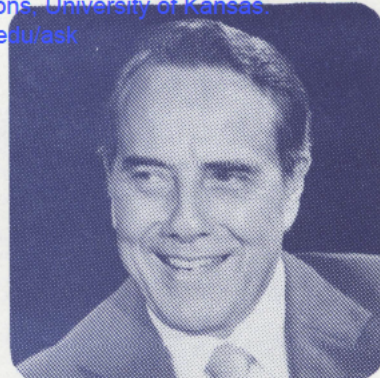

PRESIDENT REAGAN SIGNS BILL TO RENAME SOLDIER CREEK

Washington, D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole was at the White House today as President Reagan signed into law a bill sponsored by Dole that will name the Soldier Creek Diversion Unit in Topeka for Lewis M. Paramore.

Paramore worked to control the creek in North Topeka and the Kansas River it joins.

"Lewis Paramore worked endlessly to create a flood control program for the Topeka, Kansas area," said Dole. "This bill will permanently honor him for his work. We will remember him for his service to the people of Topeka."
