DOLE LOGS 75,000 MILES ON CAMPAIGN TRIAL FOR GOP CANDIDATES:
HITS FIVE STATES DAY BEFORE ELECTIONS

MOLINE, ILLINOIS -- WITH SOME LAST HOUR WHIRLWIND CAMPAIGNING IN MONTANA, NEBRASKA, ILLINOIS, IOWA, AND WISCONSIN TODAY; SENATE GOP LEADER BOB DOLE WILL WRAP UP A GRUELING 7-MONTH, 75,000 MILE, 37-STATE CAMPAIGN ROAD TOUR FOR REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES.

ACCORDING TO THE SENATOR'S OFFICE, DOLE HAS APPEARED ON BEHALF OF MORE THAN 80 CANDIDATES AT THE NATIONAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LEVELS. AS A KEY SURROGATE FOR GEORGE BUSH, DOLE HAS KEYNOTED 18 STATE CONVENTIONS, PARTICIPATED IN ALL THREE NATIONAL UNITY RALLIES, AND CAMPAIGNED EXTENSIVELY FOR THE BUSH-QUAYLE TICKET THROUGHOUT AMERICA, INCLUDING THE FARM BELT, WHERE SENATOR DOLE DID WELL IN THE GOP PRIMARIES AND CAUCUSES.

"GEORGE BUSH IS GOING TO BE THE NEXT PRESIDENT. I'VE CRISS-CROSSED THE COUNTRY, AND THERE'S NO DOUBT THAT BUSH IS HEADED TO A BIG, BIG VICTORY. I'VE BEEN WORKING HARD TO SEE REPUBLICANS PICK UP SEATS IN THE HOUSE AND RECAPTURE THE MAJORITY IN THE SENATE," DOLE SAID.

"IT JUST SEEMS TO ME, THAT IF PEOPLE ARE GOING TO VOTE FOR GEORGE BUSH, AS THEY WILL, THEN THEY OUGHT TO VOTE FOR MEN AND WOMEN WHO WILL BE WORKING WITH THE NEW PRESIDENT INSTEAD OF WORKING AGAINST HIM. WE'VE LOGGED A LOT OF MILES, AND MET A LOT OF GREAT PEOPLE ALONG THE WAY, AND THAT'S WHAT MAKES POLITICS SO MUCH FUN," DOLE CONCLUDED.

SENATOR DOLE WAS ALSO ACTIVE IN HIS HOME STATE OF KANSAS, SUPPORTING STATE AND LOCAL CANDIDATES WITH CAMPAIGN APPEARANCES AND CONTRIBUTIONS. THE SENATOR -- THROUGH HIS MULTI-CANDIDATE PAC, CAMPAIGN AMERICA -- HAS CONTRIBUTED MORE THAN \$300,000 TO REPUBLICAN CANDIDATES ON ALL LEVELS.
