## DOLE ANNOUNCES \$910,722 FOR FORBES FIELD

WASHINGTON - Senator Bob Dole (R-Ks) announced today that Forbes Field, Topeka, will receive \$910,722 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The funds can be used during the Fiscal Years 1990-93, but may be combined to be utilized for a particular project whose cost exceeds monies available in one particular year.

"This method of funding will speed up the process of getting this work done at Forbes Field," said Dole. "Our airports must continually be upgraded and developed to maintain dependable air transportation. An updated, modernized airport is essential for economic development in Topeka," added Dole.

The funds will be used to reconstruct an apron south of the terminal and add taxiway signs. The funding is from the FAA's Aviation Trust Fund, awarded under the Airport Improvement Program.
