DOLE SECURES \$4.3 MILLION FOR NEW INTERCHANGE IN
WYANDOTTE COUNTY;
FUNDS INCLUDED IN FY91 TRANSPORTATION APPROPRIATIONS BILL

WASHINGTON - Senator Bob Dole (R-Ks) announced today that the Senate Appropriations Committee approved \$4.345 million for the construction of a new interchange at I-70 and 110th Street in Wyandotte County, Kansas. The committee completed action on the FY1991 Transportation Appropriations bill Friday.

Dole secured the funding at the subcommittee level. The measure now moves to the Senate floor for action.

"The Kansas City, Kansas area is in dire need of this highway demonstration project. The recent construction of the Woodlands racetrack and the anticipated commercial development around the track make this project a top priority. This highway improvement project will mean more than just dollars and cents to Wyandotte County -- it will mean continued economic development and jobs for this area," said Dole.

The total cost of the new interchange and upgrading 110th Street is \$6.266 million. Kansas City, Kansas and Edwardsville will match the federal funds by contributing 30%, \$1.921 million, to complete this project.
