SALINA FIRM AWARDED CONTRACT FOR VA REPLACEMENT DOMICILIARY

WASHINGTON - Senator Bob Dole (R-Ks) announced today that a Salina firm has been awarded an architect/engineer contract for a project at the Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Leavenworth. The contract was awarded by the Department of Veterans Affairs.

Wilson & Company of Salina, was awarded a \$783,553 contract to prepare working drawings for a project to construct a replacement domiciliary and chiller plant at the medical center.

Kansas Senators Dole and Kassebaum last year helped secure \$2 million in federal funding for the \$16 million VA replacement domiciliary project in the FY90 VA/HUD appropriations bill.

"This project is finally getting underway with this first contract award. I was pleased Congress passed initial funding last year. I intend to continue to work hard to assure sufficient funding levels are met to complete this project," said Dole.
