DOLE ANNOUNCES \$1.3 MILLION FOR FAMILY HOUSING ASSISTANCE IN KANSAS

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole announced today \$1,321,237 in grants to provide housing assistance for families in several communities in Kansas. The funding is from the Department of Housing and Urban Development under a newly restructured program, Section 8 Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS), that uses housing assistance to leverage other resources and supportive services, such as child care or job training, to help recipients become self-sufficient.

Section 8 is the federal government's main rental subsidy program for low-income persons. Under the FSS program, families receive assistance either under the voucher or the certificate program, which have different requirements for the rent that may be charged and the percentage of income that tenants must contribute towards that rent.

"This funding will go directly to Kansas communities so families that need assistance can obtain affordable housing. Nothing is as basic as decent shelter and these programs will help promote economic independence and self-sufficiency," said Dole. "I'm pleased that the federal government is extending this helping hand to needy Kansans."
