FT. RILEY EXPANSION

ARMY DROPS PLANS FOR MORE LAND AT FORT RILEY;
DOLE CALLS IT WIN/WIN

WASHINGTON -- The United States Army has decided to drop its plans to acquire more land around Fort Riley, a decision applauded today by Senator Bob Dole (R-Kansas).

"This is a win/win decision for the greater Fort Riley area," Dole said. "Family farmers will no longer have to worry about giving up their land, and the Army has assured me that today's decision in no way diminishes its strong support for this important military base.

"I have insisted from the start of this controversy that the Army owed our state a thorough and fair review, and to demonstrate an absolute need for every extra inch of land. The Army has come to the conclusion that it does not need any more land for training purposes. With tight budgets, adequate existing facilities and the high-tech success in the Persian Gulf, it looks like the right decision to me.

"Meanwhile, I will continue to do all I can to make certain that Fort Riley remains one of America's premier installations. Kansas is proud of the Big Red One, and we are certainly aware of the tremendous role the Fort plays in our state's economy. Still, there are no guarantees, with changing defense missions in the post-Cold War world, and as Congressional pressure to gut the military continues on Capitol Hill."

Senator Dole has played an active role in the ongoing discussions between the Army, local officials and landowners. In order to keep this critical issue on the front burner, Senator Dole went right to the top, bringing to Kansas Secretary of Defense Dick Cheney, Army Chief-of-Staff Carl Vuono and Secretary of the Army Michael Stone for personal inspections at Fort Riley and the surrounding area.

IF DEMOCRACY FAILS IN THE FORMER SOVIET UNION, WHO KNOWS WHAT WILL FOLLOW. WHO KNOWS WHOSE FINGERS WILL FINALLY END UP ON THOSE NUCLEAR BUTTONS IN MOSCOW, KIEV, OR KAZAKHSTAN.

IF FREE MARKETS ARE ALLOWED TO FAIL IN THE FORMER SOVIET UNION, IT WILL NOT ONLY BE THE PEOPLE OF THOSE NEW DEMOCRACIES WHO WILL SUFFER. AMERICANS WILL BE THE LOSERS, TOO. WE WILL LOSE VAST NEW MARKETS FOR OUR PRODUCTS -- MARKETS WHICH, ALREADY ARE VITAL TO THE HEALTH OF THE KANSAS FARM ECONOMY. WE WILL LOST A VAST NEW ARENA FOR LUCRATIVE INVESTMENT.

OF COURSE, WE HAVE TO KEEP OUR EYE ON THE BALL. THROWING MONEY AT MOSCOW WILL NOT SOLVE MOSCOW'S PROBLEMS, ANYMORE THAN THROWING MONEY AT OUR CITIES, SUBURBS AND FARMS WILL SOLVE OUR

THAT'S THE WAY TO GO, TO HELP RUSSIA AND THE OTHER FLEDGLING DEMOCRACIES; TO PRESERVE AMERICA'S LEADERSHIP ROLE IN THE WORLD; AND TO ADVANCE THE LONG-TERM INTERESTS OF OUR OWN NATION AND PEOPLE.
