GOP STOPPING DEFICIT SPENDING, NOT STOPPING GOVERNMENT: ISSUE HIGHLIGHTS FUNDAMENTAL DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PARTIES; REPUBLICANS PROTECTING TAXPAYERS -- WHITE HOUSE STILL DOESN'T GET IT

CINCINNATI, OHIO -- Senate Republican Leader Bob Dole today issued the following statement regarding the status of President Clinton's so-called stimulus package:

"President Clinton can't lock-out Republicans and hide behind the 'gridlock' gimmick any longer. We're not stopping the government, we're stopping the Democrats' deficit spending and saving the taxpayers a bundle.
