SENATOR DOLE HONORED BY FORT LEAVENWORTH SCHOOL DISTRICT

WASHINGTON -- At a presentation in the U.S. Capitol Wednesday, the Fort Leavenworth school district honored Kansas Senator Bob Dole for his efforts to ensure quality education for the district's children. Throughout his career, Senator Dole has been an ardent supporter of the Impact Aid program which provides schools with federal dollars to educate children of military personnel and native Americans. Most recently, Senator Dole and Senator Kassebaum headed off an attempt to divert \$300,000 in federal assistance from the Fort Leavenworth school district.

The president of the school board, retired Colonel Stephen Kempf, and district superintendent Dr. Tom Devlin and his wife Carla made the presentation, a painting by second-grader Megan Devries of a sunflower on a blue background. The artwork was accompanied by a letter to Senator Dole, which said "the future for thousands of military children who will attend the Fort Leavenworth schools is brighter because of your interest and generous gift of time."

The Fort Leavenworth delegation was in the nation's capital to attend a National Association of Federally Impacted Schools conference.
