**DOLE PROPOSAL FOR NICKELL BARRACKS TRAINING CENTER**  
**APPROVED BY SENATE**

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole's request for \$4.4 million to complete construction of the Nickell Barracks Training Center in Salina cleared its final hurdle in the U.S. Senate today. The Kansas Army National Guard project was included in the 1995 Military Construction Appropriations Bill which now heads to the President's desk to be signed into law.

"In light of the current reduction of military forces, the construction of Nickell Barracks Training Center will help to provide our men and women with the training and equipment they need as the Guard and Reserve play a greater role in our nation's force structure," said Dole.

The funding will allow for the completion of the Center, construction of a military education facility, visiting unit headquarters, facilities maintenance center, and vehicle storage compound.
