**DOLE PROPOSAL FOR MANHATTAN GRAIN MARKETING RESEARCH LAB**  
**RENOVATION WINS FINAL SENATE APPROVAL**

WASHINGTON - The U.S. Senate Tuesday night approved \$950,000 in funding proposed by Senator Bob Dole for the planning and design renovation of the Agriculture Research Service Grain Marketing Research Lab in Manhattan. The project was included in the 1995 Agriculture Appropriations Bill which now heads to the President's desk to be signed into law.

"The caliber of research conducted at the Grain Marketing Research Lab is second to none," Dole said. "These funds will help the Lab to make necessary upgrades to its facilities so that it can continue its leadership role in the agriculture research community into the 21st century."

The bill allocates funds for planning and design of essential structural repairs for the building, which was constructed in 1972.
