DOLE PROPOSAL FOR KANSAS CITY, KANSAS HIGHWAY PROJECT
WINS FINAL SENATE APPROVAL

WASHINGTON - The U.S. Senate today gave final approval to Kansas Senator Bob Dole's request to restore \$3.6 million for the construction of an interchange at I-70 and 110th Street in Kansas City, Kansas. The project was included in the 1995 Transportation Bill, which will now heads to the President's desk to be signed into law.

"The I-70 and 110th Street interchange region is wide open for residential and business development. The Woodlands race track already draws significant numbers into the area and the proposed location of the Land of Oz theme park with its hotel, RV park and related facilities has the potential to attract even more local activity. This funding will help to accommodate rapid growth in this vital region of Kansas City."

This bill replaces the original \$3.44 million granted in the 1994 Earthquake Supplemental Appropriations Bill, which was rescinded after the deadline for construction expired.
