Congressman Bob Dole, Sixth District Kansas Republican has been advised by Acting Commissioner of Education, Wayne O. Reed that an application of Wilson School District Joint No. 10 for financial assistance under the provisions of Public Law 874 has been approved.

"To be eligible for assistance under this Act, a school district must have had an unexpected increase in school enrollment by children who reside on Federal property or with a parent employed on Federal Property in the same State as the local School District or within reasonable commuting distance of the District", Dole explained.

Reed Advised the total amount of entitlement for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 1961 is \$5,915.00, and that \$3,770.00 is being made available for immediate payment. Reed explained that funds available for fiscal year 1961 will require proration of payments at approximately 85% of the tentative entitlement of \$5,915.00.
