"UNDER THIS PROGRAM, BUILDINGS ARE CONSTRUCTED WITH PRIVATE FUNDS AND DO NOT BECOME PROPERTY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, BUT ARE LEASED BY THE POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT", DOLE EXPLAINED.

SUCCESSFUL BIDDER FOR THE WINONA BUILDING IS WALLACE LODGE 318, AF & AM.

GROUNDBREAKING AND CONSTRUCTION ARE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN SOON WITH A COMPLETION DATE OF JULY 31, 1961.

DOLE STATED HE WAS INFORMED THE BUILDING WILL PROVIDE 1361 SQUARE FEET OF INTERIOR SPACE WITH AIR CONDITIONING AND A DUAL LOBBY.
