CONGRESSMAN BOB DOLE, SIXTH DISTRICT KANSAS REPUBLICAN HAS BEEN ADVISED BY COMMISSIONER SIDNEY H. WOOLNER OF THE COMMUNITY FACILITIES ADMINISTRATION THAT AN ADVANCE OF \$550 HAS BEEN MADE TO THE CITY OF COURTLAND, KANSAS FOR PRELIMINARY PLANNING OF A SEWER SYSTEM.

THE COST OF THE PROJECT IS ESTIMATED AT \$102,000 WITH CONSTRUCTION TO START IN 1963.

THIS PROJECT IS BEING ASSISTED UNDER THE PROGRAM OF ADVANCES FOR PUBLIC WORKS PLANNING AUTHORIZED BY THE HOUSING ACT OF 1954, AS AMENDED. THE PROGRAM PROVIDES INTEREST-FREE ADVANCES FOR PLANNING ESSENTIAL TO PUBLIC WORKS AND COMMUNITY FACILITIES. ADVANCES ARE REPAYABLE ON START OF CONSTRUCTION.
