Congressman Bob Dole (R., 6th Dist., Kansas) announced today he will be entitled to make one appointment to West Point, one to the Air Force Academy, three appointments to the Naval Academy, and to make ten nominations to the Merchant Marine Academy for the 1962-63 academic year.

Eligibility requirements for appointment to academies, other than physical and scholastic requirements, are U.S. Citizenship, at least 17 years of age and not over 22 years of age on or before July 1 of the year in which admission is desired, of good moral character, must not be nor have ever been married. Applicants must be residents of the Sixth Congressional District of Kansas.

All eligible persons interested in an appointment should contact Congressman Dole, Room 244, House Office Building, Washington 25, D. C., before October 19, 1961 and eligible applicants will be requested to take a Civil Service Examination early in November. Exact time and place of the examinations will be announced soon.
