Congressman Bob Dole, Sixth District Kansas Republican has been contacted by farmers in the Schilling Missile Complex who are protesting regulations forbidding terracing across easements on their land.

At a recent meeting of Soil Conservation District representatives, farmers in this area, told Dole the Department of the Air Force had issued instructions prohibiting terracing on its easements.

"These farmers contend they cannot successfully carry out a conservation plan on their farms calling for terraces if these easements cannot be crossed," Dole said.

"Furthermore, farmers maintain the communication lines buried in these easements would be protected against uncontrolled erosion."

Dole stated he is contacting Air Force officials in efforts to find a satisfactory solution.
