

PRESS RELEASE FROM THE OFFICE OF
CONGRESSMAN BOB DOLE (R-KANSAS)

Cong. Bob Dole (R-Kansas) renewed his demand for an investigation of the Billie Sol Estes matter in the House Committee on Agriculture this morning. Dole indicated that while awaiting final action on the Administration farm bill, the Administration sugar program and other legislation, that the Departmental Oversight and Consumer Relations Subcommittee, of which Dole is a member, could commence investigation into alleged scandals within the Department of Agriculture.

Chairman Harold Cooley (D-North Carolina) indicated there were already many investigations being conducted and that a further investigation by the Subcommittee on Departmental Oversight and Consumer Relations would be of no value.

Dole stated he would continue his efforts as available information clearly indicates the need for quick and complete Congressional investigation before any "white-wash" is completed.
