Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kansas) announced he is accepting applications from young men interested in entering service academies for the 1963 class. Applicants must be single between the ages of 17 and 22 as of July 1, 1963, must have graduated from high school by July, 1963, and must reside in the area covered by the Sixth Congressional District of Kansas. All applicants will be required to take a Civil Service Examination which has been tentatively scheduled for September 22 in Goodland, Hays and Salina. "The Academy Screening Board which proved very successful last year will again be utilized in making final selections," Congressman Dole stated.

"Appointments are open to the U. S. Military Academy, the U. S. Naval Academy and the U. S. Air Force Academy. Ten men can also be nominated to take the U. S. Merchant Marine Academy exam. Applications cannot be accepted after September 7, 1962, because of the time needed to process applications, hence I trust interested young men will contact my office as soon as possible."
