Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kansas), stated today that he has accepted an invitation from the Sterling Chamber of Commerce, Sterling, Kansas, to debate his opponent, J. Floyd Breeding. The invitation from the Sterling Chamber of Commerce stems from a challenge Dole made to his opponent last Saturday evening in Lyons, Kansas, where both made appearance at a League of Women Voters meeting.

In accepting the invitation, Dole stated he felt, "both candidates have a responsibility to the voters to discuss the issues in a public debate." Dole concluded he could not understand Breeding's reluctance to discuss real issues.
