## OVER HALF MILLION DOLLARS TO KANSAS IN OEO GRANTS.

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced 12 grants from the Office of Economic Opportunity to various Kansas state and local agencies. The grants total \$545,050, and will enable the agencies to continue the administration and services provided by their programs for three months.
