DOLE RESOLUTION WOULD SET UP PRESIDENTIAL COUNCIL ON MIA'S

WASHINGTON, D.C.--A Resolution introduced this afternoon by Senator Bob Dole calls on President Ford to establish a Presidential Council on MIA's. Dole, who met earlier today with Kansas MIA families and a national MIA group, said he would present the same request to the President when he meets with him this afternoon.

Dole said there appears to be a lack of effective action being taken or proposed to achieve a full accounting of MIA's. He said the Presidential Council should be used "to propose courses of action to achieve a full accounting, and to make recommendations concerning Federal policies related to MIA's."
