FHA LOAN, GRANT TO AID 390 RURAL KANSAS FAMILIES

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced a \$300,000 grant and \$1,360,000 loan to Rural Water District No. 12 of Jefferson County from the Farmers Home Administration.

The water distribution system being assisted will serve 390 rural families in Jefferson and Leavenworth Counties, in the Oskaloosa, Winchester, McLouth and Leavenworth areas. The system consists of 190 miles of PVC water line, 3 standpipes and 3 wells. The well field is located just south of Nortonville. The system will improve living conditions and economy of the area, many families have previously had to haul water and others use wells which are inadequate.
