LEGISLATION INCLUDES \$10.7 MILLION FOR KANSAS PROJECTS

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senator Bob Dole said today that the Senate Appropriations Committee has included \$10.7 million supplemental FY 1975 funding for 5 Kansas Corps of Engineer projects in the Emergency Employment Act of 1975. The Committee action, completed late Thursday, came after Dole had requested the supplemental funding be appropriated.

In letters to the Chairman of the Committee, Senator John L. McClellan and the ranking Republican, Senator Milton Young, Dole said the "amounts recommended by the House Committee were inadequate in terms of Corps capability for this fiscal year." The Kansas Senator recommended--and the Senate Committee included in their final bill--the following amounts of supplemental funding:

Big Hill Lake (Coffeyville)	\$ 300,000.
Clinton Lake (Lawrence)	2,800,000.
El Dorado Lake.	3,000,000.
Hillsdale Lake (Paola).	4,000,000.
Kansas City, Kansas River	600,000.

Dole said the success of the Emergency Employment Appropriations Act "in providing jobs to significantly reduce unemployment will depend upon the wise distribution of those emergency funds which Congress appropriates for this purpose. The Kansas projects will be particularly suitable for achieving the goals contained in the Act," Dole added.

The bill will next have to be approved by the full Senate.
