Statement of Senator Bob Dole concerning Vietnam: of South Viet

"IN A DELICATE SITUATION, I THINK PRESIDENT FORD IS TO BE COMMENDED FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE EVACUATION EFFORT.

CLEARLY THE QUESTION OF MILITARY AID IS NO LONGER AN ISSUE, AND I WOULD QUESTION THE WISDOM OF SENDING ANY ADDITIONAL AID WHATSOEVER UNLESS WE COULD BE ASSURED THAT IT WAS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY RELIABLE INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND NOT BY THE COMMUNISTS WHO MIGHT BE EXPECTED TO TURN IT TO THEIR OWN BENEFIT."
