SIX HEW GRANTS TO KU TOTAL \$273,727

WASHINGTON, D.C.--Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson and Congressman Larry Winn today announced five grants from the Department of Health, Education and Welfare to various departments and individuals at the University of Kansas.

- \$24,875 K.U., National Defense Foreign Language Fellowships

- \$15,502 Graduate School, Research Administration, Fulbright-Hays Faculty Research Abroad Program

- \$50,580 Slavic and Soviet Area Studies, for NDEA Center for Soviet and East European language and area studies
