Attorney General 1968-70

G.O.P. Gubernatorial candidate 1970

became Assistant Attorney General for Land and Natural Resources 1970 (Justice Dept.)

while at Justice was 7th and final negotiator sent to settle Wounded Knee

May 1972 became Solicitor to the Department of Interior (considered #3 spot)

has served several times as Acting Secretary
